In addition to the USA Cycling Rulebook (<u>https://usacycling.org/resources/rulebook</u>) you are responsible for reading and following the rules set forth in this Technical Guide.

The following items are of particular importance:

- **Parking:** Parking is VERY LIMITED for TT and RR. Please carpool. Park only where indicated. No Reserved parking for teams. Obey all volunteer traffic control directions.
- Time Trial roads are all open to traffic. When walking or riding pay attention to vehicles. NO walking or standing on the open road. The Goodyear Police will enforce and ticket if necessary.
- Portable Toilets: Please use them. Absolutely NO Public urination or uncovered changing.
- Helmets: Must be worn and secured at all times while on a bicycle.
- Road Race Traffic: On race day Hwy 387 is ONE-WAY ONLY

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE REQUESTS WILL RESULT IN FINES &/OR DISQUALIFICATION

This is a 3-day timed stage race based on cumulative time. The winner from each category will have the lowest elapsed time over the course of the 3-day race.

Omnium Category 5 Men, 5 Men Masters 40+, 5 Women winner is based on the following points:

REGISTRATION

PRE REGISTRATION ONLY. Online registration is at <u>https://www.bikereg.com/vos</u>.

- NO REFUNDS ALLOWED ONCE REGISTRATION CLOSES
- NO rider substitutions or replacements are allowed
- Riders must register for the category listed on their USA Cycling license. Riders will not be allowed to change their category at the race
- Riders must have a current USA Cycling license. ONLY Sr Men Cat 5, Sr Women Cat 5 & Masters are eligible for one-day beginner licenses

Early - Thursday 2/13/2025 4pm - 8pm, Landis Cyclery, 2180 E Southern Ave, Tempe, AZ 85282 Time Trial - Friday 2/14/2025 starting at 7:30 am at Time Trial Start area and open all day. Omnium Category 5 Road Race and Criterium - Before each stage at sign in.

All riders must show a valid, current license. International riders must show a foreign permission letter.

SIGN-IN

Riders are REQUIRED to sign-in before the Road Race & Criterium

(There is no sign-in required for the TT). Failure to sign-in will result in a fine of \$20.00 for the first offense, per USAC rules. Check individual stage details for sign-in locations and additional instructions.

SCORING

Riders MUST complete each stage in order to start the next except for all Category 5 omnium. Racers that miss the TT will get the slowest time in their category +10 minute penalty and may start the road race.

TIME BONUSES

- Road Race Finish: Will have time bonuses of 10, 6 and 4 seconds for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd finishers.
- Road Race King Of the Mountain and Queen Of the Mountain: On selected laps Time bonuses of 5, 3 and 2 seconds for 1st, 2nd and 3rd respectively
- Criterium: Will have time bonuses of 10, 6 and 4 seconds for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd finishers.

PROTESTS

DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL YOU HAVE REVIEWED THE FINAL ONLINE RESULTS!

Time Trial: Protests must be made to the Chief Judge up to 1 hour prior to the start of the Road Race. **Road Race:** Protests must be made to the Chief Judge up to 1 hour prior to the start of the Criterium. **Criterium:** Protests for the Crit must be made to the Chief Judge within 15 minutes of posting.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Time Trial awards for the top 5 riders for each category will be held at the Time Trial. Road Race, Criterum and Final GC Awards including all cash prizes will be held at the Criterium. Omnium Category 5 Men, 5 Men Masters 40+, 5 Women will have awards for top 3 at Time Trial and Criterium.

CENTERLINE

All roads are open to traffic. Obey and respect all police officer, official, and staff requests. If you cross the centerline you will be disqualified! If no painted centerline marking exists, riders must keep to the right side of the road at all times.

Giordana LEADER'S JERSEY

The GC leader for every category must wear the Giordana Leaders Jersey for every stage.

- Time Trial GC leaders will pick up their jerseys at the TT awards ceremony
- **Road Race GC** leaders will pick up their jerseys at the Crit during sign-in

RACE NUMBERS

Each rider will be given two (2) bib numbers. No frame number.

DO NOT CUT, FOLD or ALTER NUMBERS!

Riders altering numbers Subject to fine.

Jersey Numbers

- All riders MUST WEAR BOTH bib numbers for all stages. If you do not wear both bib numbers you will be assessed a 20-second penalty!
- Numbers must be worn on the lower part of the jersey Right side: along the side seam Left side: on or above jersey pocket

COMBINED CATEGORIES

- Masters Men 40+ & Masters Men 50+ will race together but will be scored separately.
- Masters Men 60+ & Masters Men 70+ will race together but will be scored separately.
- Men Cat 5 and Men Cat 5 40+ will race together but will be scored separately.
- Women 4/5, Masters Women 35+ & 50+ will race together but will be scored separately.

UNDER-23 RIDERS

The highest placed U-23 rider in Men Pro -1 and Women Pro 1, 2 receive a cash prize, but will not be scored separately.





SAFESPORT

The Valley of the Sun SR is a USA Cycling sanctioned event and aligns with USAC guidelines in that athlete safety and well-being is of the utmost importance. To help create a safe environment that is free from misconduct and abuse at all USA Cycling events, please review USA Cycling's Safe Sport Program Policies, including reporting requirements and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP). All Participants at USA Cycling sanctioned events must abide by these policies.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

All participants at this event are expected to refrain from engaging in Prohibited Conduct as defined by the US Center for SafeSport Code. Prohibited Conduct includes but is not limited to the following: sexual misconduct, emotional misconduct, physical misconduct, bullying, harassment, hazing, and violations of the MAAPP.

MAAPP

LOCATION: The Time Trial Start is located at: 25100 South Rainbow Valley Rd, Buckeye, AZ 85326 Follow I-10 W, Take exit 127 for Bullard Ave to Estrella Pkwy to W Willis Rd to S Rainbow Valley Rd in Goodyear. Please drive carefully and watch for cyclists on the roadway. Roads are open to traffic. Obey all traffic laws.

PARKING: is located off pavement on the WEST side of S Rainbow Valley Rd. only between W Chandler Heights Rd and W Riggs Rd. **Please comply with the parking directors' instructions.**

COURSE DESCRIPTION: On country roads that are **open to traffic**. The course is 10 miles out and back. There will be course marshals and police at the start, finish and turnaround. https://www.mapmyride.com/routes/view/5319263341/

****JR's ages 9 - 14** will complete a 5 mile out and back course.

WARM UP

The course is closed to warm-up session after 8:00 am. We recommend warming up on a trainer if possible. Warmup is also available on W Riggs Rd West of the intersection of Riggs and S Rainbow Valley Rd.

No Time Trial Bikes for All Juniors, Men 5, Men 5 40+ and Women 5, Cat 5 racers will follow the same Time Trial bike rules that the juniors follow.

Start: On Riggs Rd 100 meters East of S Rainbow Valley Rd.

VEHICLES: The only vehicles permitted on the course are officials and race staff. A sweep vehicle will be on the course at all times to pick up riders.

NEUTRAL WHEEL SUPPORT: Is not provided during the TT and team cars are NOT permitted to follow racers.

MECHANICALS/FLAT TIRES: If you have a flat in the TT you can either fix the flat yourself OR you can wait for the sweep vehicle to pick you up. After verification by an official (blue shirt), the rider will be awarded the same time as the slowest racer in the same category and may start the road race stage.







Stage 2 – Silverhawk Private Wealth, Arizona, The Grand Canyon State, Road Race AZ 387 & Tamarack Way, Casa Grande AZ, 85194 Saturday, 15 February 2025

DIRECTIONS

HWY 387 IS ONE-WAY ONLY FROM WEST TO EAST UNTIL THE LAST RACE IS COMPLETE AND DPS APPROVES

AZ-387, Casa Grande, AZ 85194

(Enter from I-10) From Phoenix, take I-10 East towards Tucson.

Travel approximately 20 miles to **State Route 187/387 (exit 185).** Take exit 185 and head East (left) crossing over I-10. Turn right on **SR 387** southeast for about 1 mile to parking/start.

IMPORTANT

We use this course courtesy of the **Gila River Indian Reservation**, the Arizona Dept of Transportation, and the Arizona Department of Public Safety.

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING

NO PARKING AT FINISH

FEED ZONE PARKING IS BY PERMIT ONLY AND EXTREMELY LIMITED

NO LITTERING

All trash, water bottles, gel packets, etc **MUST** be tossed at the feed zone or at the Start line.

On areas outside of state road right-of-way for any reason.

NO PARKING

PARKING

The **ONLY** designated parking area is on the **South side of SR 387** (see map on page 12 and 13 for details). Please follow the parking directions of the volunteer.

Park on the shoulder all the way off the road. NO parking within 200 meters of the start line.

FEED ZONE PARKING IS BY PERMIT ONLY AND EXTREMELY LIMITED. Permits will be available at the RR

sign-in only. If you do not have a feed zone parking permit, plan on carpooling with someone that does. The feed zone is located on the north side of Highway 387 before the finish. Feeding is only allowed in the designated zone. Feeders must stay on the shoulder and feed only from the right side of the road. **Please make sure you clean up you trash/empty bottles and leave nothing behind**.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The road race course is a 16 mile course consisting of 3 straights and 3 right hand corners and 470 ft of climbing per lap. The course is **open to traffic**. Centerline rule is in affect (see page 5). Be **cautious at the corners** (Please view the map on page 12 for details).

VEHICLES ON COURSE

The course is **open to traffic**. All racers and groups of racers must NEUTRALIZE when approaching any vehicles especially medical vehicles on the course.

COURSE HAZARDS / NEUTRAL START

There is a cattle guard immediately after the corner #1 and rumble strips on Hwy 87. The start will be neutral on the first lap until groups pass the cattle guard after the first right hand turn.

JUNIOR/MINOR MEDICAL

Minor racers must have a parent, guardian, or a coach present to refuse EMT treatment to a minor.

WHEEL SUPPORT

All follow vehicles will be wheels in/wheels out. This means if you flat, you only get a wheel if you put one in. Vehicles may become neutral (meaning anyone can have a wheel) if there are surplus of wheels. If you received a spare during the race you MUST return it immediately following the race.

<u>Wheel drop off</u> - Take spare wheels to the follow vehicles at least **30 minutes before your race** with the approved wheel tag. Wheel tags will be available at packet pickup and sign-in

<u>Post race wheel pickup</u> – Wheels will be returned to the start area. Please **pickup your wheels immediately following your race**. Do not expect them to be transported to the crit. *The White Mountain Road Club, sponsors, officials and volunteers are not responsible for any equipment left at the race.*

ON RACE DAY HWY 387 IS ONE-WAY ONLY FROM WEST TO EAST UNTIL THE LAST 2ND WAVE RACE IS COMPLETE AND DPS APPROVES

(Enter from I-10 & Exit to Hwy 87) First wave racers must exit the parking area traveling from west to east before 11:00 am or wait until the second wave races are finished at 4:00 pm. No Vehicles allowed to exit after 11:00 am. This rule is for rider safety.

RACE FINISH LINE

NO 3 Kilometer mechanical rule on uphill finish.

KOM/QOM

Will be judged at the finish line. The number for the KOM/QOM relates to which time you are going to cross the finish line.

For example; most of the morning races have 2.8 laps to complete, which means those races will cross the finish line 3 times,

The KOM/QOM is on lap 2 so the 2nd time you cross the line is the sprint bonus.





Stage 3 Trilogy Veterinary Medical Center Criterium Arizona State Capitol Sunday, 16 February 2025

LOCATION: Downtown Phoenix on South 17th Ave. and West Jefferson St. by the Arizona State Capitol. 1645 W Jefferson St, Phoenix, AZ 85007



TEAM PARKING AREA: Entrance is on Jefferson St. from 19th Ave from the west of the course. **A Team parking permit is required to access this area. Only one vehicle per team permitted.**

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The criterium course is a flat figure eight shaped 1.6 km (1 mile) course. It is traversed in a clockwise direction. Watch out for raised road "buttons." The finish is approximately 250 meters after the last corner.

WHEEL PIT service provided by Elite Racing Services (ERS).

MEDICAL at the start/finish line.

SIGN IN at the start/finish line North of course. You must sign in 10 minutes prior to the race start.

FREE LAP rule is in effect until three laps to go. Riders with legitimate incident and unable to return within Free Laps will be placed at the end of the field they were with and same time.

RIDER STAGING prior to the start at Jefferson St and 17th Ave. Wait for official call up.

LAPPED RIDERS will be pulled, with the exception of Juniors, Para-cycle and some smaller fields. This is at the discretion of the race officials.

AWARD CEREMONIES will be announced throughout the day. Riders must be present at the ceremony to collect prizes.

PRIMES can be picked up at the Start/Finish trailer behind the barricades.


